1 <u>Minutes of last meeting.</u> – Correct.

2 **County Co-ordinator.**

We have some very well organised clubs and others that would benefit from some support. It was decided that we should employ a county co-ordinator. This position would be advertised on the Warwickshire website.

Action -

The need to be computer "savvy".

Knowledge of squash and racketball.

Attend committee meetings and AGM.

The salary would be between £5000 and £6000 per annum plus expenses for 1 day per week (8hrs).

3 Register of Coaches.

Action -

Mo to organise First Aid course and inform the coaches.

Safeguarding can be completed on line as can the DBS checks – ID verification is done at the Post Office.

4 Affiliation and Registration.

All clubs entering a team in the Winter Leagues must be affiliated and all players must have activated their affiliation. Summer Leagues will be a "practice run".

Action – Roger to find out how long it will take to add a new player.

5 <u>"App" use.</u>

There is an "App" which makes it very easy for coaches to inform England Squash about the activities they are organising at our county clubs. The County will receive extra funding from England Squash if they know of all the activities that are taking place.

Action – Nigel to ask coaches to use the "App".

6 Commonwealth Games.

There is to be a weekend (29th -30th June 2019) of "showcasing" the sports that will be in the Commonwealth Games. Jo Robotham has asked if we will lead the squash display.

Action – Nigel to ask Jo for more details but most likely we will be happy to run the squash event.

7 Finances

8 <u>County Teams.</u>

Ladies' Report.

The senior team were promoted so are now in the Premier League again. We do not compare very well with other teams in the Premier since we have very few young professional players.
